APPENDIX B. Lifecycle Report

<u>Projects Ramp, Basement Stairwell walls, stairs, and enclosure</u> <u>ACE Architecture</u>

The projects have been delayed as the winter season is upon us; a winter build would cost an additional \$20,000 - \$30,000 which the CA cannot absorb.

<u>Capital Conversation Grant (CCG)</u> grant application was submitted to the city on September 18, 2023. The grant application was reviewed and forwarded to the grant group; it will take 6-8 weeks for the city to confirm grant approval.

CFEP Grant

The provincial grant intake opens January 15, 2023, this gives KCA an opportunity to apply for more funding to support the projects. Depending on the outcome of the CCG grant funding approval amount, KCA may apply for a CFEP grant, but confirmation of grant approval is scheduled for July 15, 2023.

Power Brush Ice Sweeper

I drove downtown to the Calgary Parks Foundation (CPF) office to pick up logos. Pictures were taken of Dick and me with the power brush, showing the CPF logos applied to the machine and a testimonial report was submitted to CPF as these two items were the grant obligation.

I received email from Eilysh Zurock dated September17, 2023, stating "Thank you so much for sending your testimonial. I really enjoyed seeing the photos and hearing that your rink was able to host the local school. Your granting requirements are all wrapped up."

I completed a survey with CPF regarding the grant on behalf of Kingsland.

Rink Winter Ice Maintenance Seasonal Contractor

Isaiah (who was contractor) last year contacted Dick and I that he was interested in the job again this year. Dick and I met with Isaiah during our meeting Dick communicated that he wants Isaiah to take on more of leadership role. Isaiah contract was signed effective November 1, 2023.

Dick communicated that he was not going to take on role of contact person for KCA rink management. He will stand-by on a consulting basis only.

I met with Lars Stevenson, Open Director will take on the role of volunteer contact person for the CA, Dick will help with the transition period. I will also stand-by to assist as required.

Trico Picnic Tables

November 6, 2023 received email from Jen, an email forwarded from Tanya at the preschool. Communicating that has settled around the new tables have soil that this around them and it a safety hazard.

November 7, 2023, I sent an email to Felipe (Trico). The Trico team came out the next day and applied fill in the areas around the concrete with topsoil, good dirt to allow the grass to grow.
